**Background**

1. Section 308 of the County Charter provides that a special appropriation is an appropriation which states that it is necessary to meet an unforeseen disaster or other emergency, or to act without delay in the public interest. Each special appropriation shall be approved by not less than six Councilmembers. The Council may approve a special appropriation at any time after public notice by news release. Each special appropriation shall specify the source of funds to finance it.
2. A new coronavirus disease, named COVID-19, appeared in China in December 2019 and spread extremely quickly. On March 11, 2020 the World Health Organization declared the disease a pandemic. The April 11, 2020 situation report from the World Health Organization stated that the number of confirmed cases worldwide has exceeded 1.6 million, (approximately 1.5 million more than 1 month earlier). As of April 12, 2020, there were 1,631 cases and 42 deaths in Montgomery County.
3. To slow the spread of the disease, Governor Hogan declared a State of Emergency and has issued several Executive Orders with actions that include, but are not limited to, closing schools, closing senior centers and adult medical day care programs, and limiting the number of people that can gather.
4. On April 9<sup>th</sup> the County's Health Officer issued a Directive requiring employees and customers in grocery stores (including farmers' markets), pharmacies, and large chain retail establishments to wear face coverings.
5. The efforts to contain the spread of the disease has resulted in a global shortage of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

6. Montgomery County is home to local businesses who can produce PPE; several local businesses have begun the process, but the Montgomery County Economic Development Corporation (MCEDC) believes more local businesses can begin production by covering modest costs to retrofit production lines.
7. A FY20 Operating Budget special appropriation is requested for the Montgomery County Economic Development Corporation Non-Departmental Account:

8. This special appropriation is needed so that MCEDC can incentivize local businesses to retrofit production lines to produce additional PPE.
9. Notice of public hearing was given and a public hearing was held.
