DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

Resolution 19-472, Section G authorizes non-competitive contract awards. The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) is recommending two amendments that will allow the Department of Health and Human Services to enter into a contract with Lachman Consulting LLC for a leadership development program for the Continuum of Care (CoC) and with COG to provide a racial disparity study the ability of people in the region exit homelessness.

SUMMARY OF KEY DISCUSSION POINTS

- Both these contracts are funded through the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Continuum of Care planning grant to Montgomery County.
- The Continuum of Care (CoC) is a system of government and non-government service providers that serve the homeless and formerly homeless population. In Montgomery County, the CoC works to make homelessness rare, brief, and non-recurring.
