DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

Resolution 19-872, Section G authorizes non-competitive contract awards. The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) is recommending an amendment to authorize the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to establish a new contract with the Montgomery County Food Council to design strategies to end childhood hunger in the County in the amount of \$100,000. No new appropriation is required for this contract.

Section 11B-14 (a) (4) of the Montgomery County Code states that "a contract may be awardedwithout competition if the Chief Administrative Officer makes a written determination that the contract award serves a public purpose and proposed contractor has been identified in a grant or appropriation resolution approved by the Council." The result of this action is to amend the FiscalYear (FY) 2022 Designation of Entities for Non-Competitive Contract Award status resolution to include the entities listed below.
