REMEMBRANCE AND RECONCILIATION COMMISSION

<u>Created</u> --	Established by County Council Resolution, adopted January 29, 2019, amended by County Council Resolution 19-291, adopted November 5, 2019, establishing that ex officio members are non-voting and must be appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council.
<u>Purpose</u> --	The Commission, to be comprised of community leaders, has been established to bring the community together and promote understanding of County history. The Commission will work with the national Equal Justice Initiative (EJI) and other stakeholders to claim and install the County's monument commemorating the three locations in the County where lynchings have been documented. The Commission will create and install historical markers, and collect and display soil from each of the locations, and will also design programs to advance the dialogue that the monument, historical markers, and soil should foster.
<u>Membership</u> -	The 19-member Commission must have ten (10) public members and nine (9) non-voting ex officio members , appointed by the County Executive after consulting with the Office of Human Rights, and confirmed by the County Council. The ex officios must include one representative from each of the following organizations: Montgomery County Human Rights Commission, Rockville Human Rights Commission, Lincoln Park Historical Foundation, Maryland National Capital Park & Planning Commission, Maryland Lynching Memorial Project, Arts and Humanities Commission of Montgomery County, Montgomery College, Montgomery County Public Schools, and the Montgomery County Historical Society.

Eirich Seeks Applicants for Remembrance and Reconciliation Commission

County Executive Marc Eirich is seeking applicants to fill five public vacancies on the Remembrance and Reconciliation Commission. Three incumbents are eligible to apply for reappointment.

The 19-member Commission, comprised of community leaders, was established to bring the community together and promote understanding of County history. Public members are appointed by the County Executive, after consulting with the Office of Human Rights, subject to confirmation by the County Council. The Commission also has nine ex officio members from the following organizations: Montgomery County Human Rights Commission, Rockville Human Rights Commission, Lincoln Park Historical Foundation, Maryland National Capital Park & Planning Commission, Maryland Lynching Memorial Project, Arts and Humanities Commission of Montgomery County, Montgomery College, Montgomery County Public Schools, and the Montgomery County Historical Society. The Commission works with the national Equal Justice Initiative (EJI) and other stakeholders to claim and install the County's monument commemorating the three locations in the County where lynchings have been documented. The Commission creates and installs historical markers, and collects and displays soil from each of the locations, and also designs programs to advance the dialogue that the monument, historical markers, and soil should foster.

Members will serve for the duration of the Commission, without compensation, but are eligible for reimbursement for travel and dependent care for in-person meetings attended. The Commission currently meets virtually by video- and teleconference the fourth Tuesday of every month at 5:00 PM am. When in-person meetings resume in the future, the Commission will meet in Rockville.

Applicants of diverse backgrounds, professions, genders, geography, abilities, ethnicities, and ages are encouraged to apply. Members of County boards, committees and commissions may not serve on more than one such group at a time. Members must complete training on the Maryland Open Meetings Act and basic parliamentary procedure. The County Executive's appointments are subject to confirmation by the County Council. Applications will be forwarded to the Council for confirmation and may be made public as part of the confirmation process. The deadline for application is **April 23, 2021**. **To apply please click "Apply for Position" below** to complete the online form and provide a cover letter and resume (in one document).
