**Introduction**

## SUBJECT

Supplemental Appropriation to the FY23 Operating Budget, Montgomery County Government, Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Service, Emergency Service Transporter Supplemental Payment Program, \$557,000 (Source of Funds: Emergency Service Transporter Supplemental Payment Program and Other Intergovernmental Revenue)

## DESCRIPTION/ISSUE

The County Council will introduce this supplemental appropriation.

## SUMMARY OF KEY DISCUSSION POINTS

- The County Executive recommended this supplemental appropriation on July 5, 2022.
- The Emergency Service Transporter Supplemental Payment Program provides supplemental payments to qualifies entities supplying emergency ambulance transportation services to Medicaid recipients through an amendment to the State’s Medicaid plan.
- Reimbursements through this program are entirely federally funded and significantly increase reimbursement for Medicaid transports.
- This appropriation will fund eligible expenditures in MCFRS in FY23, including: the Emergency Medical Service Quality Assurance Battalion Chief Position approved in the FY23 budget; upgrade a position added in the FY23 budget from firefighter to lieutenant to provide adequate supervision at Sandy Spring Fire Station 40; and to support delivery of an Emergency Medical Technician Cadet Program in partnership with Montgomery County Public Schools in the 2022-2023 school year.
- The Council is tentatively scheduled to hold a Public Hearing and consider Action on this supplemental appropriation on July 26, 2022.

Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Service  
Emergency Service Transporter Supplemental Payment Program, \$557,000

I am recommending a Supplemental Appropriation to the FY23 Operating Budget of the Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Service in the amount of \$557,000 for the Emergency Service Transporter Supplemental Payment Program. Effective October 1, 2020, this program provides supplemental payments to qualified entities supplying emergency ambulance transportation services to Medicaid recipients through an amendment to the State's Medicaid plan. Reimbursements through this program are entirely federally funded and significantly increase reimbursement for Medicaid transports. This Appropriation will fund eligible expenditures in the Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Service Operating Budget and recognize additional Emergency Service Transporter Supplemental Payment Program revenue anticipated in FY23.

This increase is needed to enhance funding for the Emergency Medical Service Quality Assurance Battalion Chief Position approved in the FY23 Budget to allow service to begin at the start of the fiscal year prior to recruit graduation; upgrade a position added in the FY23 approved budget from firefighter to lieutenant to provide adequate supervision at Sandy Spring Fire Station 40; and to support delivery of an Emergency Medical Technician Cadet Program in partnership with Montgomery County Public Schools in the 2022-2023 school year.

**Background**

- Section 307 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that any supplemental appropriation shall be recommended by the County Executive who shall specify the source of funds to finance it. The Council shall hold a public hearing on each proposed supplemental appropriation after at least one week’s notice. A supplemental appropriation that would comply with, avail the County of, or put into effect a grant or a Federal, State or County law or regulation, or one that is approved after January 1 of any fiscal year, requires an affirmative vote of five Councilmembers. A supplemental appropriation for any other purpose that is approved before January 1 of any fiscal year requires an affirmative vote of six Councilmembers. The Council may, in a single action, approve more than one supplemental appropriation. The Executive may disapprove or reduce a supplemental appropriation, and the Council may reapprove the appropriation, as if it were an item in the annual budget.
- The County Executive has requested the following FY23 Operating Budget appropriation increases for the Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Service:

3. This increase is needed to enhance funding for the Emergency Medical Service Quality Assurance Battalion Chief position approved in the FY23 budget to allow service to begin at the start of the fiscal year prior to recruit graduation; upgrade a position added in the FY23 approved budget from firefighter to lieutenant to provide adequate supervision at Sandy Spring Fire Station 40; and to support delivery of an Emergency Medical Technician Cadet Program in partnership with Montgomery County Public Schools in the 2022-2023 school year.
4. The County Executive recommends a supplemental appropriation to the FY23 Operating Budget in the amount of \$557,000 for the Emergency Service Transporter Supplemental Payment Program and specifies that the source of funds will be Emergency Service Transporter Supplemental Payment Program revenues and Other Intergovernmental revenues.
5. Notice of public hearing was given, and a public hearing was held.
