### American Community Survey (ACS)


- Annually •



Montgomery County Demographic Trends




### 2021 pop = 1.05M

Montgomery County's population = 17% of the Maryland state population



### New Council districts have approximately 44,000 fewer people than old districts





# Population concentrated around core centers and corridors




# Population density by district and countywide

















## Household composition (1960-2021)





### Household composition by district and countywide





## Housing tenure by district and countywide






# Age distribution by race or ethnicity


## Age distribution by district and countywide

### 2021 Median Household Income







# Percentage of renter households spending >35% of income on housing costs





### Educational attainment by district and countywide





# Place of work by district and countywide


