FY24 COUNTY EXECUTIVE RECOMMENDATION

The annual payment to Takoma Park Library is calculated with a set historical formula that estimates the reimbursement of municipal taxes. The FY24 recommended budget reflects an increase of 2.7% from FY23 to \$172,4163 or 4.6% of the City of Takoma Park's FY23-24 proposed expenditures of ~\$1.5M for the library. The Education & Culture Committee held a worksession on April 20, 2023.

¹ Council Reconciliation List High Priority Categorization as of May 9, 2023 → 1-Required/little choice to fund; 2-Critical for an essential program; 3-Important program or service that deserves to be funded; 4-Room for debate on priority/high priority.

- Maryland State Retirement System: Unfunded accrued liability, as established by the Maryland State Retirement System (MSRS), for employees hired prior to July 1, 1984, who are members of the MSRS (including former Department of Social Services employees hired prior to July 1, 1984), and for those who have retired (all County employees participated in the State Retirement System until 1965.) The County's contribution for this account is determined by State actuaries.
 Beginning in FY81, the amount due was placed on a 40-year amortization schedule. The funding of the 40-year amortization schedule was completed in FY20.
- State Library Retirement: Accrued liability for retirement costs for three Montgomery County Public Library retirees who are receiving a State retirement benefit. These were County employees prior to 1966 who opted to stay in the State plan. The County no longer receives bills for these costs.
