16	(f)	obtaining [[energy commodities]] electricity natural gas, and compressed natural
17		gas under [[procedures approved]] executive regulations developed by the Chief
18		Administrative Officer and approved by the County Council; and
19	(g)	any other procurement exempted from this Chapter by another law.
