SUBJECT: Setting Transportation Fees, Charges, and Fares

Background


1. With the enactment of Bill 16-04, as of July 22, 2004 all fees, charges, and fares for any transportation or transportation-related service or product provided by the Department of Public Works and Transportation must be set by Council resolution adopted after a public hearing and approved by the Executive, unless any law expressly requires a different process. If the Executive disapproves a resolution within 10 days after it is adopted and the Council readopts it by a vote of six Councilmembers, or if the Executive does not act within 10 days after the Council adopts it, the resolution takes effect. Any fee, charge, or fare in effect on July 22, 2004 will remain in effect until amended by Council resolution as provided in Section 2-57 of the County Code as amended by Bill 16-04.
2. The fees, charges, and fares in effect on July 22, 2004 remained in effect until it was amended by Council Resolution 15-789 on October 12, 2004.
3. To encourage parking practice that will improve pedestrian and driver safety, the Council wishes to raise to \$50 per violation for most parking fines related to safety. The Council also wishes to clarify and correct some of the fines and transit fares as described in Resolution 15-789.
4. Most of the parking fees in the Silver Spring Parking Lot District have not been raised for many years. The fees at parking meters cannot be raised until the mechanical meters are changed out. The Executive has recommended funding to replace the mechanical meters with electronic meters during Fiscal Year 2006. Therefore, effective April 1, 2006, the Council wishes to raise the Silver Spring Parking Lot District parking fees to help fund the District's program and to allow the District to more rapidly pay back its loan from the General Fund.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County approves the following resolution:


Transportation fares, fees, and charges in Resolution 15-789 are amended as described in Table 1, attached.
