SUBJECT: Extension of Time for Council Action on Executive Regulation 20-07, Overtime Offset Fees

Background

1. On August 2, 2007, the County Council received Executive Regulation 20-07, Overtime Offset Fees from the Executive. Executive Regulation 20-07 would modify the Department of Permitting Services' offset fee structure by splitting the plan review portion of the fee from the inspection service. The fee is charged when overtime services are requested by the customer in order to expedite action by DPS on a particular request. The plan review overtime charge would be 125% of the regular rate. The overtime inspection work would be billed at a rate of \$90 per hour with a minimum of three hours when it involves a DPS employee returning to work.
2. Under Method (2), if the Council does not approve or disapprove a regulation within 60 days after the Council receives the regulation, it is automatically approved and takes effect the day after the deadline for approval or a later date specified in the regulation.
3. County Code Section 2A-15 allows the Council by resolution to extend the deadline for action on a regulation under Method (2).
4. The Planning, Housing, and Economic Development Committee is scheduled to discuss this regulation on September 24, 2007. If the Committee recommends amendments for consideration by the Executive, Council action on an amended regulation will not occur until October 2, 2007 or later.
5. Deadline for Council action on Executive Regulation 20-07 is October 1, 2007.

Action

The County Council for Montgomery County Maryland approves the following resolution:

The Council extends the time for action on Executive Regulation 20-07, Overtime Offset Fees, to December 31, 2007.
