SUBJECT: Extension of Time for Issuance of Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendation on Local Map Amendment No. G-851 and Local Map Amendment No. G-861

Background


1. Pursuant to Section 59-H-5.1 of the Zoning Ordinance, the Hearing Examiner is required to forward to the District Council a written report and recommendation within 45 days after the closing of the record on any local map amendment application unless such time is extended by the District Council.
2. The record in LMA G-851 closed on September 14, 2007, and the time for the issuance of the Hearing Examiner's report expires on October 19, 2007. The record in LMA G-861 closed on September 7, 2007, and the time for the issuance of the Hearing Examiner's report expires on October 22, 2007.
3. Due to workload constraints and complex legal issues in these cases, the Hearing Examiner has requested a two-week extension of time to forward a Report and Recommendation to the District Council for G-851 and a six-week extension for G-861.

Action

For these reasons, the County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Montgomery County, Maryland, approved the following resolution:

The period for issuance of the Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendation on Local Map Amendment No. G-851 is extended to the close of business on November 2, 2007, and the period for issuance of the Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendation on Local Map Amendment No. G-861 is extended to the close of business on November 30, 2007.
