SUBJECT: Extension of Time for Council Action on Executive Regulation 13-06, Taxicab Customer Service Plans and Service Requirements

Background

1. Executive Regulation 13-06 would establish specific taxicab customer service requirements, minimum performance criteria, and the requirements for a customer service plan as required under County Code Sections 53-110 and 53-222.
2. On February 28, 2008, the County Council received Executive Regulation 13-06, Taxicab Customer Service Plans and Service Requirements from the Executive.
3. Under Method (2), if the Council does not approve or disapprove a regulation within 60 days after the Council receives the regulation, it is automatically approved and takes effect the day after the deadline for approval or a later date specified in the regulation.
4. County Code Section 2A-15 allows the Council by resolution to extend the deadline for action on a regulation under Method (2).
5. On April 22, 2008, the Council adopted Resolution No. 16-513, which extended time for Council action on Executive Regulation 13-06 until June 27, 2008.
6. On June 24, 2008, the Council adopted Resolution No. 16-626, which extended time for Council action on Executive Regulation 13-06 until December 31, 2008.
7. On December 9, 2008, the Council adopted Resolution No. 16-796, which extended time for Council action on Executive Regulation 13-06 until June 30, 2009.
8. On June 30, 2009, the Council adopted Resolution No. 16-1029, which extended time for Council action on Executive Regulation 13-06 until December 31, 2009.

Action

The Council extends the time for action on Executive Regulation 13-06, Taxicab Customer Service Plans and Service Requirements, to June 30, 2010.
