AN AMENDMENT to the Montgomery County Zoning Ordinance for the purpose of:

- defining a place of assembly;
- allowing temporary signs totaling 50 square feet at any place of assembly; and
- generally amending provisions related to signs for a place of assembly.

By amending the following sections of the Montgomery County Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 59 of the Montgomery County Code:

OPINION

Zoning Text Amendment No. 06-23 was introduced on August 1, 2006 for the purpose of defining a place of assembly; allowing temporary signs totaling 50 square feet at any place of assembly; and generally amending provisions related to signs for a place of assembly.

The Montgomery County Planning Board in its report to the Council recommended that the text amendment be approved.

The County Council held a public hearing on September 21, 2006, to receive testimony concerning the proposed text amendment. The text amendment was referred to the Planning, Housing, and Economic Development Committee for review and recommendation.

The Planning, Housing, and Economic Development Committee held a worksession on September 28, 2006 to review the amendment. The Committee recommended approval of ZTA 06-23 with amendments. The Committee recommended establishing a 24-square-foot limit on the total area of temporary signs for places of assembly and retaining a 10-square-foot limit for limited duration signs in residential zones.

The District Council reviewed Zoning Text Amendment No. 06-23 at a worksession held on October 17, 2006, and agreed with the recommendations of the Planning, Housing, and Economic Development Committee except that the Council approved a 50 square foot limit on the total area of temporary signs. The Council believed that a 50 square foot temporary sign would aid communication particularly along major roadways.

For these reasons and because to approve this amendment will assist in the coordinated, comprehensive, adjusted and systematic development of the Maryland-Washington Regional District located in Montgomery County, Zoning Text Amendment No. 06-23 will be approved as amended.

ORDINANCE

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that portion of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following ordinance:

6 **Place of assembly:** Any place of worship, school, library, museum, or hospital.

24 entrance to the building or driveway to identify the location of
25 the building for a user[s] of the facility.

40 **59-F-6.2. Requirements by Zone.**

41 The following requirements apply in the zones specified:


42 (a) **Residential Zone.**

- 43 (1) The number of signs is not limited.
- 44 (2) Total sign area must not exceed 10 square feet. However, the total
45 sign area at any place of assembly must not exceed 50 square feet.

47 **Sec. 5. Effective date.** This ordinance takes effect 20 days after the date of
48 Council adoption.
