**SUBJECT:** Action to Extend Effective Date for Temporary Executive Regulation 18-06T, Requirements and Procedures for the Workforce Housing Program, Department of Housing and Community Affairs

**Background**


1. On November 27, 2006, the County Council received Temporary Executive Regulation 18-06T, Requirements and Procedures for the Workforce Housing Program, Department of Housing and Community Affairs.
2. A Temporary Executive Regulation is effective when the County Council receives a copy from the issuer with an explanation why its immediate adoption is necessary. A Temporary Regulation is effective for not more than 90 days. Temporary Executive Regulation 18-06T will expire on February 25, 2007.
3. The issuer may ask the Council to extend the effective period for up to an additional 90 days and must provide a compelling reason for an extension. The Council must not extend a Temporary Executive Regulation more than once.
4. On February 7, 2007 the Council received a request from the County Executive to extend Temporary Executive Regulation 18-06T for an additional 90 days.

**Action**

*The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, approves the following resolution:*

The effective date for Temporary Executive Regulation 18-06T, Requirements and Procedures for the Workforce Housing Program, Department of Housing and Community Affairs, is extended to May 26, 2007.
