30 the Chief transmits must specify:


31 [(A)] (i) the amount of this account the Chief recommends to  
32 allocate to replace apparatus that is owned [and  
33 staffed] by local fire and rescue departments in the  
34 next fiscal year; and

35 [(B)] (ii) the amount of this account to allocate to facilities,  
36 training, gear, administrative staff, volunteer  
37 recruitment and retention, volunteer standby  
38 support, and equipment for volunteers.]]

39 Any administrative staff hired or retained by a local fire  
40 and rescue department using revenue allocated under this  
41 Section is not a County employee or a member of the  
42 separate merit system referred to in Section 21-16(a).
