Sec. 1. Section 5-101 is amended as follows: 1 2 5-101. Definitions. In this Chapter, the following words and phrases have the following meanings: 3 4 At large: A dog, except a service animal, is at large if it is outside the owner's 5 premises and not leashed, unless it is in a dog exercise area designated by either 6 the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, or a 7 municipality, or is participating in a qualified activity. Any other animal is at 8 large if it is outside the owner's premises and is not leashed or immediately 9 responsive to verbal or non-verbal direction.
