COUNTY COUNCIL FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY, MARYLAND

Lead Sponsor: Council President at the request of the County Executive

AN ACT to:

- (1) change the membership of the Cable and Communications Advisory Committee;
- (2) change the membership composition of the Commission on Veterans Affairs;
- (3) change the name of the Committee on Hate/Violence to the Committee Against Hate Violence; and
- (4) generally amend the laws related to boards, committees, and commissions.

By amending

Chapter 8A, Cable Communications
Section 8A-30

Chapter 24, Health and Sanitation
Section 24-61

Chapter 27, Human Rights and Civil Liberties
Section 27-63

The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Act:

Sec 1. Sections 8A-30, 24-61, and 27-63 is amended as follows:

8A-30. Cable and Communications Advisory Committee.

* * *

(c) The Advisory Committee must have [15] 9 voting members appointed by the Executive and confirmed by the Council for 3-year terms. The members should broadly represent technology areas.

(d) The [membership must include] Executive must appoint one representative selected by the Montgomery County Chapter of the Maryland Municipal League[;], one representative selected by the City of Rockville[;], and one representative selected by the City of Takoma Park. However, if any of these organizations do not provide a representative, the representative may be selected from the public at large.

(e) The Executive must appoint 6 members selected from the public at large.

(f) The members annually must elect the chairperson and vice chairperson of the Committee. A person must not serve more than 2 consecutive terms as chairperson.

[(e)] (g) Members are subject to Chapter 19A.

Sec. 24-61. Commission on Veterans Affairs.

* * *

(c) *Composition; Term.*

(1) The Commission has 16 voting members.

(2) The Executive should appoint [8] 9 members who are veterans and may be a member of a veterans group, such as:

(A) Vietnam Veterans of America;

(B) American Veterans (AMVETS);

(C) Disabled American Veterans;

(D) Veterans of Foreign Wars;

- 28 (E) Women Veterans of America;
 29 (F) American Legion; or
 30 (G) Military Order of the Purple Heart.
- 31 (3) The Executive must appoint 4 members to represent the general
 32 public.
- 33 (4) The Executive must designate the following ex officio members:
 34 (A) the Director of the Department of Health and Human
 35 Services, or the Director's designee;
 36 (B) [the Director of the Department of Economic Development,
 37 or the Director's designee;
 38 (C)] the County Executive or the Executive's designee; and
 39 [(D)] (C) the President of Montgomery College or the President's
 40 designee.



42 **27-63. Committee [on] Against Hate/Violence.**

- 43 (a) *Members.* The County Executive must appoint, subject to confirmation
 44 by the County Council, a Committee [on] Against Hate/Violence. The
 45 Committee consists of 15 voting members and 6 ex-officio nonvoting
 46 members. Each voting member must, when appointed, reside in the
 47 County.
