SUBJECT: An Application submitted by the Hebrew Home of Greater Washington to obtain \$50,000 in Tax Credits

Background

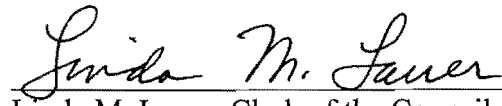
1. The State of Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (MDDHCD), has established the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.
2. The Community Investment Tax Credit Program (CITC) is a part of the Smart Growth initiative designed to promote efforts to support a variety of projects for special populations, to provide a source of funds for assistance, and to support projects undertaken by the nonprofit sector.
3. CITC provides tax credits to corporations that donate funds to nonprofit organizations that provide services and projects to special populations throughout the state.
4. Montgomery County supports the provision of housing, medical and rehabilitative care to low income seniors.
5. The Hebrew Home of Greater Washington provides long-term medical care, short-term rehabilitative care and subsidized housing to seniors including those who may not have the means to pay.
6. Under CITC, The Hebrew Home has applied to MDDHCD for their Charity Care Program to receive an allocation of \$50,000 tax credits for business entities that make contributions.
7. The County Executive and the County Council support the Hebrew Home of Greater Washington's application for \$50,000 in tax credits. This support is given as specified in COMAR 5.14.01.05B(10)(a).

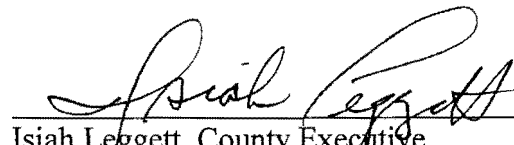

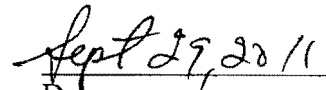
The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Resolution:
