SUBJECT: An Application Submitted by Hope Connections for Cancer Support to the State of Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit (CITC) Program for Acquiring Tax Credits

Background

1. The State of Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (MDDHCD), has established the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.
2. The Community Investment Tax Credit Program (CITC) is a part of the Smart Growth initiative designed to promote efforts to support a variety of projects for special populations, to provide a source of funds for assistance, and to support projects undertaken by the nonprofit sector.
3. CITC provides tax credits to corporations that donate funds to nonprofit organizations that provide services and projects to special populations throughout the state.
4. Montgomery County supports programs that improve the mental and physical health of individuals and families that are impacted by cancer.
5. Hope Connections for Cancer Support provides professionally facilitated emotional support, workshops and education to individuals and families that are impacted by cancer.
6. Under CITC, Hope Connections for Cancer Support has applied to MDDHCD for approval of an allocation of \$50,000 in tax credits for business entities that contribute.
7. The County Executive and the County Council support Hope Connections for Cancer Support's application for \$50,000 in tax credits. This support is given as specified in COMAR 5.14.01.05B(10)(a).

Action


The County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland approves the following Resolution:
