Please accept this Memorandum as notice that as of October 21, 2021, Montgomery County's COVID-19 transmission status has improved, and the County is now considered to be an area of "moderate transmission."

Pursuant to the August 5, 2021 Board of Health Resolution, the face covering requirement will remain in place until such time as the County achieves 7 consecutive days of moderate transmission. I will send additional notification once the County achieves that milestone.
