You can **arrange for bulk trash pick up** (*if 4 or more bags of trash or debris is collected*) 24/7 by submitting a service request on the [MC311 website](#) or call 311 (*outside the County call 240-777-0311*).

Removal of Down Trees or Limbs. To report trees that have fallen on sidewalks or in the public right-of-way call 311. Trees fallen on utility lines report to your local utility company.

Be sure to mention its an Adopt A Road sign and include your group name and the location of the damaged or missing sign(s). You will be assigned a work order number that you can use when following up.
