## **Invitation to Public Meeting** Residential Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Permit Guidelines

PURPOSE:

The <u>Montgomery County Department of Transportation</u> (MCDOT) and <u>Department of</u> <u>Permitting Services</u> will hold a public meeting to brief the community on and receive feedback about the new <u>Residential EV Charging Permit</u> guidelines.

An electric vehicle charging station, also called EV charging station, supplies electric energy for the recharging of electric vehicles or, plug-in hybrids. An electrical permit is required prior to the installation of a residential EV charging station if there are no existing outlets (requiring wiring of a dedicated circuit). Electrical permits must be applied for online using <u>DPS ePermits</u>.
