Item 1,2 & 3-Introductions/Minutes/Chair's Comments: Committee Vice Chair **Barbara Condos** called the meeting to order. Members and guests introduced themselves.

Item 4 – US 355 Bus Rapid Transit Project Update: Darcy Buckley, MCDOT-BRT Project Manager, updated the Committee on the BRT project.

Topics discussed:

- Station locations some placement based on future development
- Council of Governments (COG) grant funds station prototype design that need to be adaptable for different environments
- Some station components include real-time ticketing info, windscreen, bike racks, off boarding ticket vending kiosks

- Community outreach via Corridor Advisory Committee meetings and family friendly Open Houses
- The median placement of stations two ways double-wide with buses servicing both sides; or two stations with a station servicing each direction
- Although service is not faster than driving it's more reliable local buses currently on route are the Ride On 55, 46 & Ride On Extra
- Modeling process predicts behavior which helps identify commuter travel preferences, factoring in items like cost & driving time
- No funding currently for the project until design studies are conducted for Federal regulations necessary to receive funding
- Cory Pitts will fill in as BRT Manager while Ms. Buckley is on maternity leave

Item 5 – TMD Marketing Outreach Update: Stephanie Webber reported:

• Commuter information Days (CID) held at P.F. Chang, Courtyard Marriott & Microsoft – employees expressed interest in carpooling and the new Ride On Extra bus service

Item 7 – Around the Room: Friendship Heights Village Manager **Julian Mansfield** reported lighting issues at the crosswalk at Willard in front of Whole Foods as the island and sign doesn't seem to remedy the hazard- same issue at 4701 Willard. Suggestion to utilize the Complete Streets Initiative which looks at the surrounding areas also effected for a complete fix. **Mr. Carlson** will follow up. Also discussed:

- Charles Crerand announced that garage reconstruction at Wisconsin Place starting in March will disrupt future AC meetings due to noise future meeting locations to be announced
