Item 1 & 2 – Introductions/Minutes: Members and guests introduced themselves.
November minutes were approved.

Item 3 – Washington Region Bus Transformation Project: Lora Byala, Foursquare ITP, described the goals of the Bus Transformation Project:

- The purpose is to create a new vision and a collaborative action plan for the future of bus in the region.
- The project will explore all factors that influence the quality of bus service, from technology and transit priority, to funding structures and service provision roles.
- Foursquare is currently engaged in outreach throughout the region and encourages those interested to take an online survey to weigh in with their opinions.

Item 4 – Great Seneca Short-Range Transit Plan: Gary Erenrich, MCDOT, presented a project overview the County’s transportation analysis of future growth and transit needs for the Great Seneca Science Corridor Master Plan:

- Anticipated growth in the Plan area 2017-2025:
 - 3,323 (11% increase) in households
 - 91,415 (10% increase) in population
 - 4,272 (5% increase) in jobs
- MCDOT in analyzing anonymized cell phone data to look at:
 - All travel activity from Oct 2017 – Sep 2018
 - Using origin-destination data
 - Home to work location for travelers

Item 5 – Employer Traffic Mitigation Plans: Committee members reviewed a summary of employers that have submitted mandatory TMPs and TMP Annual Reports:

- Committee recommended approval of 11 TMP Annual Reports
