**Item 1 - Introductions/Chair Comments:** Samantha Mazo called meeting to order and members and guest introduced themselves.

**Item 3 - COG Mobility Report:** Nicholas Ramfos, Council of Governments Commuter Connections Program, presented results of the “State of the Commute” survey which is published every three years covering 11 jurisdictions. The survey explains commuters travel patterns and its impact on roads and emissions. Phone interviews of 6000 workers were used to gather results around DC, MD & VA metropolitan areas.

**Item 4 - Employer TMP Annual Reports:** Mr. Carlson presented to the Committee companies to be recommended for approval that meet the minimum TMP requirements.

**Item 5- FY16 TMD Budget Priorities:** Mr. Carlson said planning should begin for the CE annual budget for FY16. The current FY15 priorities document will be circulated for updating.

**Item 6- Updates:**

- Discussion regarding the new Governor Hogan position of the Purple Line project – the Committee to use all available channels to alert the Gov. Hogan that there is support for the PL and to provide funding
- Reemberto Rodriguez announced the CE Operating Budget Forum will take place January 14th at Civic Center
- Council approved legislation to create an Advisory Committee for the White Oak Transportation Management District – there is a work session scheduled
- Falklands has resubmitted a development plan introducing more retail – discussion regarding City Place restructuring of retail
- Subdivision regulations (Chapter 50 of County Code) are under rewrite – Chapter 50 governs the developmental approval processes
- Bicycle Pedestrian Priority Impact areas-Jan. 24<sup>th</sup> meeting between State Highway Administration, MC Dept. of Transportation and the Silver Spring Citizens Advisory Board
