Wayside History

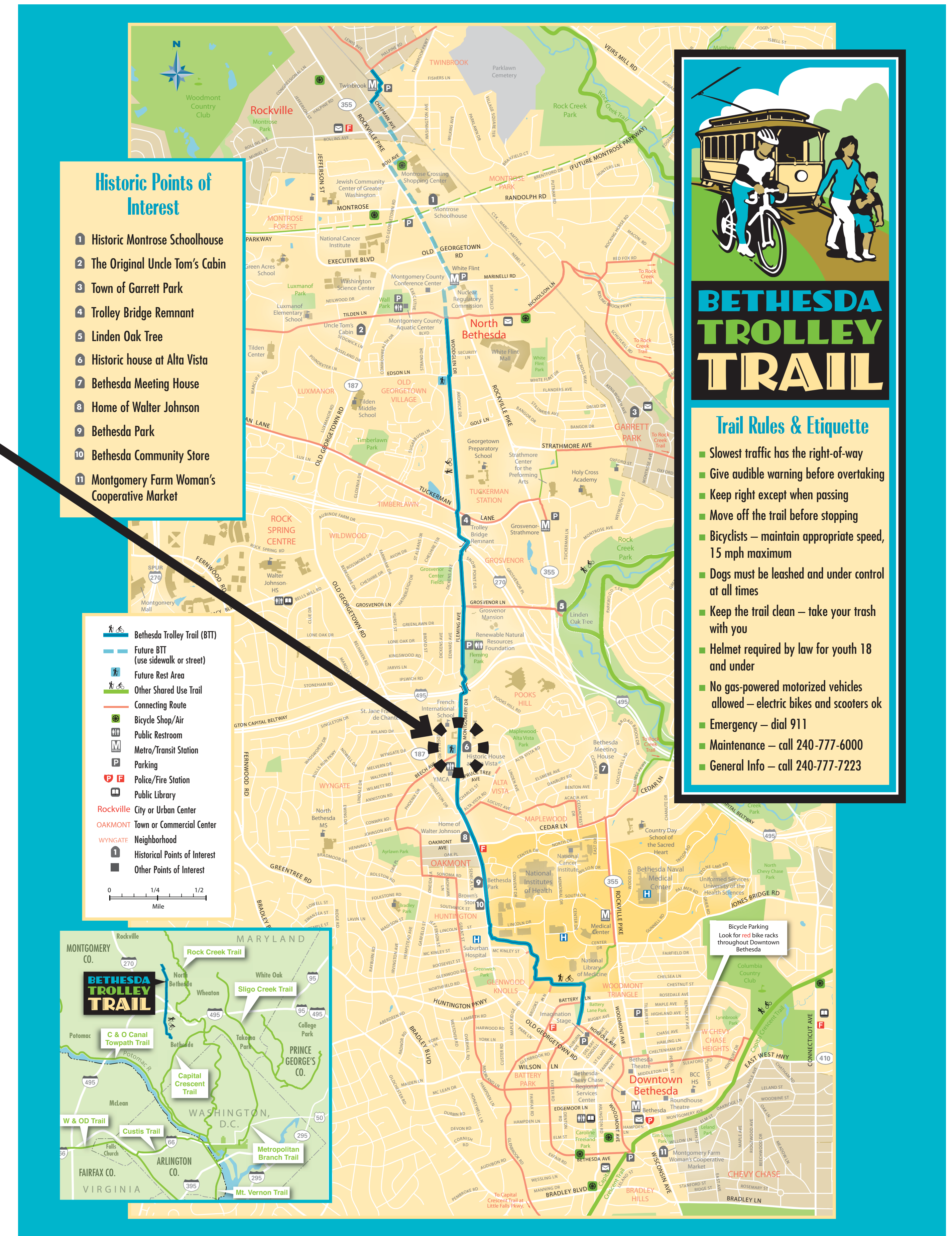
2007-2008: Trailhead and Wayside Plan Development

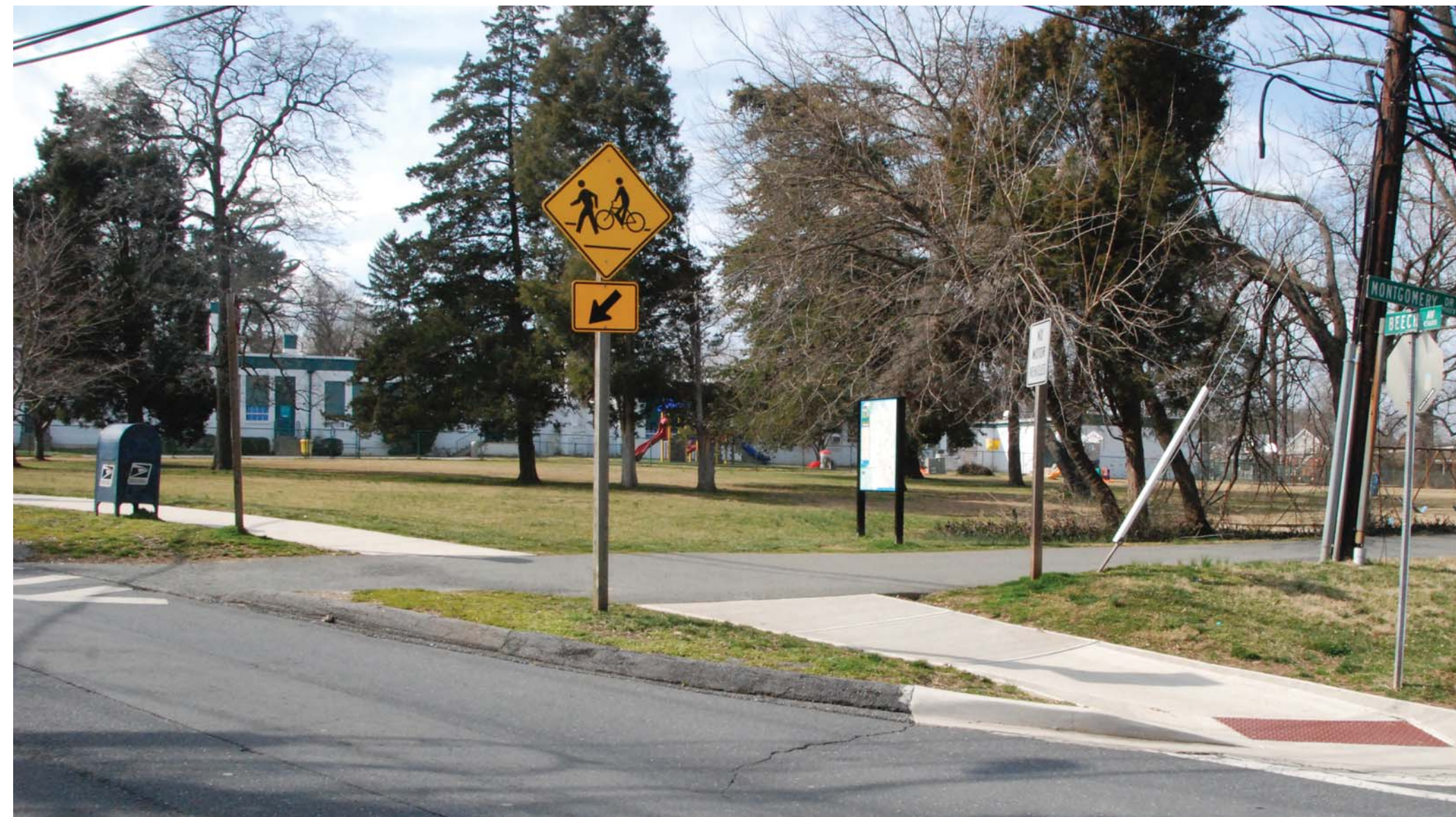

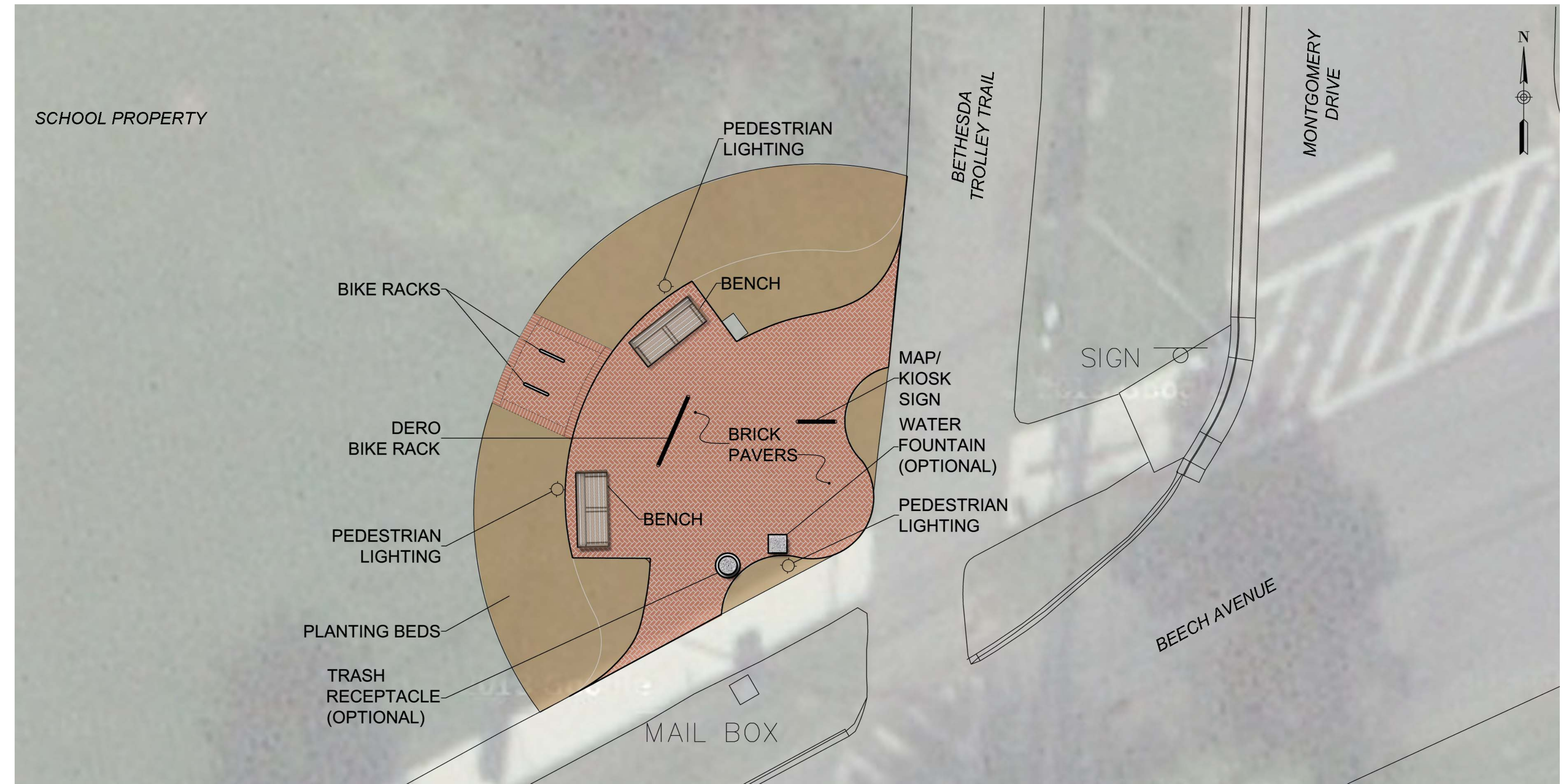
