Alloway Drive Culvert Replacement

Introduction

This project provides for the replacement of the existing 66" Corrugated Metal Pipe (CMP) storm drain culvert and headwalls with the installation of approximately 80 linear feet of new 66" Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) and headwalls & wingwalls. The work will also include new asphalt paving on both sides of the culvert approaches, installation of new chain link fencing, and landscaping.



Scope

The work to be done for the project will consist of but not be limited to the following:

- Implementation of sediment and erosion controls
- Implementation of traffic control plans and MOT (maintenance of traffic)
- Implementation of stream maintenance during the construction phase
- Removal of the existing 66" CMP culvert & wingwalls
- · Installation of the new 66" RCP culvert
- Construction of the endwalls & wingwalls
- Grading/stabilization of on-site soils
- Planting/installation of landscaping

Project Highlights

Construction to begin on or about November 14, 2022.

- The road will be closed on or about November 14th. Work to be performed under lane closures and flagging operations. Detour signs will be posted.
- Construction will take approximately 180 calendar days to complete.
- Essential County services will continue to be provided.

Traffic Control & Work Hours

Construction will take place Monday thru Friday between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Occasional Saturday work may be necessary to make up for weather days. The County will work to minimize disruptions to surrounding residents and business communities.

Contractor

Rustler Construction Inc. will be the contractor for this project. Rustler Construction, Inc. is located in Upper Marlboro, Maryland and has completed numerous similar projects for Montgomery County, and a variety of local jurisdictions, including the Maryland State Highway Administration.
