### PUBLIC HEARING FOR PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION

#### AMHERST AVENUE BIKEWAY / WHEATON, MARYLAND

Pursuant to Section 49-53 of the Montgomery County Code (2004) as amended, a hybrid public hearing shall be held on **TUESDAY, DECEMBER 12, 2023 at 6:30 p.m.** The hearing will be held in person at the County Building in Wheaton (2425 Reedie Drive, Wheaton, MD 20902) and simultaneously broadcasted over the Internet via Zoom. Residents may pre-register to testify, and the link to join the public hearing virtually will be provided upon registration.

The Amherst Avenue Bikeway project provides for the design and construction of a 2-way cycle track for an approximately 1.1-mile section of westbound Amherst Avenue between Windham Lane and Arcola Avenue. This project is identified in the Bicycle Master Plan as one of the highest-priority bikeways in the Wheaton Central Business District (CBD) in Montgomery County. Located just a block from and parallel to Georgia Avenue (MD 97), this project will improve the safety and connectivity needs of cyclists and pedestrians, including improvements to sidewalks and bus stops, the addition of a 2-way cycle track, and intersection improvements.

The Public Hearing Record Binder and displays will be available for download prior to the hearing on the project website. Audio and video of the hearing will be recorded, and a link to which will be posted on the project webpage on the MCDOT website as linked above.

The sole purpose of a public hearing is to allow residents an opportunity to present oral and/or written testimony concerning the construction of the Amherst Avenue Bikeway. The information presented may influence final design plans. The hearing will begin at 6:30 p.m. and run continuously until all information is presented and the hearing has concluded.
