PROJECT BACKGROUND: The limits of this project are from Windham Lane to Arcola Avenue on Amherst Avenue. This project will improve the safety and connectivity needs for cyclists to the vicinity of the Wheaton Central Business District (CBD), as well as cyclist and pedestrian facility improvements, such as sidewalk and bus stops reconstruction, 2-way cycletrack, and minor roadway widening.
