# THE LIFE OF TRANSPORTATION PROJECT

### COMPLETED

## FACILITY PLANNING - PHASE I

Collect data, obtain public input, develop concept plans, evaluate and select preferred alignment/cross section. Obtain Director's and Montgomery County Council's Transportation Infrastructure, Energy and Environment committee (T&E) approval

- Began March 2009
- Public meetings in October 2009 and November 2010
- Concluded in July 2011 with a recommendation by the county council T&E committee to proceed to Phase II

# FACILITY PLANNING - PHASE II WORK COMPLETED TO DATE

- Additional surveys
- Geotechnical investigation including 34 soil borings
- Conceptual stormwater management prepared and approved by Department of Permitting Services
- Coordination with SHA to include 2 additional crosswalks to increase pedestrian mobility
- Analysis of individual trees to minimize impacts

## NEXT STEPS

- Complete 35% design plans, cost estimate and project schedule
- Submit to County Council for approval to include in Capital Improvement Program (CIP)

If approved for full funding and is included in the CIP, complete final design and construction
