






Example of a one-way separated bike lane

Dixon Avenue

MCDOT is designing separated bike lanes along Dixon Avenue between Wayne Avenue and Ripley Street. These bike lanes would be one-way bike lanes separated from traffic by a barrier located on either side of the street.





Silver Spring Secure Bike Parking

The Silver Spring Secure Bike Parking Facility will be located in the base of Montgomery County parking garage 5/55 on the southeast corner of Bonifant Street and Dixon Avenue. It will provide a secure location where cyclists can lock their bikes while commuting or visiting downtown Silver Spring. This will be similar to the bike and ride facility at College Park Metro and the Bikestation at Union Station.

Project Schedule

MCDOT anticipates completing design and permitting in Summer 2019 and constructing these projects as soon as Fall 2019. The duration of construction is expected to be two to three months per project. They may not be constructed simultaneously.


