LIFE OF A TRANSPORTATION PROJECT



FACILITY PLANNING - PHASE I (2014)

- Collect Data, Obtain Public Input, Develop Concept Plans
- Evaluate and Select Preferred Alignment/Cross Section
- Obtain Director's and Montgomery County Council's Transportation Infrastructure, Energy and Environment Committee (T&E) Approval.

FACILITY PLANNING - PHASE II

- Develop 35% Design Plans
- Detail Project Schedule
- Detail Project Cost
- **Preliminary Plan**
- Submit to County Council for Approval to Include in Capital Improvement Program (CIP)

If approved for full funding and is included in the Capital Improvement Program (CIP), complete final design and construction.




Project Purpose

- Promote pedestrian and bicycle use along the Goldsboro Road corridor
- Provide connections to existing and proposed pedestrian and bicycle facilities
- Improve access for pedestrians and bicyclists to transit stops, parks and recreation areas, places of worship, schools and homes
- Enhance safety for pedestrians and bicyclists along the corridor



PROJECT LOCATION












Sidewalk with Green Buffer and Separated Bike Lanes






Sidewalk and Separated Bike Lanes

- Estimated Right-of-Way Impacts
 - 5 Properties, 10-15' width along roadway
- Estimated Project Construction Costs
 - Phase 1: \$12M
 - MacArthur Boulevard to Massachusetts Avenue
 - Phase 2: \$10M
 - Massachusetts Avenue to River Road
- Estimated Project Schedule
 - 35% Design Completion Spring 2018
 - Final Design
 To Be Determined
 - Construction
 To Be Determined
