SUBJECT: <u>Decision Memorandum – Request for Signage and Installation Announcing</u>

Public Hearing of Abandonment Case AB 770 (Kensington Blvd)

Pursuant to Montgomery County Code section 49-62 (e), DOT must post notice of a requested abandonment in or adjacent to the right of way to be closed or abandoned. Accordingly, please make the necessary arrangements to have a sign made and installed at the corner of East Avenue and Kensington Boulevard (see attached map). A virtual public hearing on the abandonment request has been scheduled for February 22, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. via the internet-based platform known as ZoomTM.

I have attached notice of the public hearing, including sign mock-up drawings, color-coded maps showing the subject area, and the requested sign location.

The sign must be installed no later than Friday, February 4, 2022. Once a Log No. and Area Engineer has been assigned to this project, a QR code sticker will be delivered to the DTEO office to adhere to the sign before installation. I will need a photo of the sign and the date it was installed for the case record. The sign should be removed any time after Thursday, March 18, 2022.


