

Life Sciences Center Loop Trail Facility Planning Study in Progress

Department of Transportation (MCDOT) is performing a planning study for a shared use path network around the Great Seneca Sciences Center (GSSC) corridor.

The 3.5 mile Life Sciences Center Loop Trail (LSCLT) is a 8 to 12 foot wide shared use path intended to be a central feature of the Life Sciences Center (LSC) area. Existing sidewalks will be widened to create the shared use path along Medical Center Drive, Omega Drive and Great Seneca Highway. As development occurs along Johns Hopkins Drive, Belward Campus Drive, Decoverly Drive and through the Public Safety Training Academy (PSTA) and Crown Farm properties, the shared use path will be constructed along with other improvements.
