Introduction

Good afternoon. Today is Thursday, October 29, 2015, and the time is approximately 6:00 p.m. We are assembled in the *Lobby Level Auditorium of the Executive Office Building, located at 101 Monroe Street in Rockville, Maryland.*

I am Gary Erenrich, designee for Montgomery County Department of Transportation and here this afternoon to conduct this public hearing. With me is Mr. Bruce Johnston from the Division of Transportation Engineering. Mr. Johnston will provide the information and details regarding the proposed project.

As a reminder, please make sure that you have signed in as you entered the room and note on the sign-in sheet whether or not you wish to speak tonight. If you have indicated that you do not wish to speak but change your mind during the hearing, there will be an opportunity for you to speak at the end of the hearing. Written comments can be submitted as well and will be considered with the same weight as oral testimony.

The subject of this public hearing is the design and construction of *the Replacement of Bridge No. MPK-03 on Park Valley Road over Sligo Creek in Sliver Spring, Maryland, and Improvements of Sligo Creek Trail in the vicinity of Park Valley Road.*

This hearing is being held pursuant to section 49-53 of the Montgomery County Code. The purpose of a public hearing is to receive comments on the proposed design of the project. Any interested persons are entitled to be heard at this hearing. However, please direct your remarks to the specific project that is the subject of this hearing. If comments stray into areas not related to this project, I will ask that you again focus your comments on the subject project.

****(If needed for substantial crowds only):***

Because of the significant interest in this project and the number of attendees who wish to speak, it will be necessary to enforce a three-minute time limit for every testimony. I'm requesting all presentations taking longer than three minutes be summarized, so as to comply with the time constraints, and provide a full written testimony to submit into the record. These submissions will be fully considered along with the oral testimony heard here today.

It is my intention to hold the hearing record open for *two weeks from today until November 12th 2015 and close of business time (5:00PM)*. This allows any person who could not attend this hearing or those who would like to present additional comments related to the information presented this evening, an opportunity to have their comments included into the record and be fully considered. Submissions may be by facsimile, e-mail or regular mail and must be received or postmarked by the close of the hearing record. Written submissions will be considered with the same weight as oral testimony.
