# Bradmoor Community Sidewalk Project

## Project to Begin Between September 28 & October 1, 2020

#### **PURPOSE**

This newsletter is to inform you of the upcoming sidewalk installation on the following roadways:

- ♦ the East side of Ewing Drive from Bradley Boulevard to McKinley Street;
- the South side of Folkstone Road from Ewing Drive to Irvington Avenue;
- the West side of Hempstead Avenue from McKinley Street to Roosevelt Street;
- the East side of Hempstead Avenue from McKinley Street to the existing sidewalk at the intersection of Hartsdale Avenue;
- the South side of McKinley Street from Rayburn Road to Garfield Street.

Please see the Project Vicinity Maps located on the reverse side of this newsletter.



#### BACKGROUND

The Annual Sidewalk Program is a section of The Montgomery County Department of Transportation's (MCDOT) Division of Transportation Engineering (DTE). The afore-mentioned sidewalk was proposed to the impacted and neighboring residents on March 29, 2019 and was the subject of a Public Hearing on November 6, 2019. On May 12, 2020, the Recommendations approving the sidewalk installation were signed by Director, Christopher Conklin.

#### SCOPE OF PROJECT

A 5-ft-wide concrete sidewalk with a variable 0 to 2-ft greenspace will be constructed on the above-referenced roadways.

#### **SCHEDULE**

This project is scheduled to begin between September 28th and October 1st of 2020, and will take approximately 4 to 6 weeks, weather permitting, to complete. Work hours will be between 5. 7am and 5pm, Monday through Friday.



#### PROJECT WORK PLAN

Generally, the work will proceed as follows:

- Tree Removal The trees that are slated for removal will be removed beginning on or about September 28, 2020. Construction may take place simultaneously. No parking signs will be placed around the subject trees prior to removing.
- Markings in Right of Way & No Parking Signs - Sidewalk locations will be marked out in white paint in the public right-of-way. No parking signs will be erected along the limits of sidewalk installation.
- 3. Excavation for Setting of Sidewalk Forms— The excavation will begin for sidewalk construction and the placement of concrete forms for the pouring of concrete sidewalk, lead-walks and driveway aprons, if applicable.



- Pouring of Concrete— Once concrete has cured, the forms will be removed and topsoil, seed and straw will be add to backfill to meet with existing grade.
- Sealant A sealant will be sprayed upon sidewalk and driveway aprons to preserve and protect the sidewalk from harsh winter chemicals.
