Jones Lane Community Sidewalk Proposal APPROVED

Dear Residents:

After a complete review of the Record binder and Public Hearing Officer's Recommendations for the Jones Lane Community Sidewalk Proposal, Christopher Conklin, the Director of the Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT), has approved and authorized the installation of the Jones Lane proposed sidewalk.

The new sidewalks will be installed in 5-ft-wide concrete with a variable greenspace of 0 to 3-feet along the following:

- > the west side of Jones Lane from Rt. 28/Darnestown Road to Falconbridge Drive;
- > the east side of **Jones Lane** from **Falconbridge Drive** to **Lloydminster Drive**; and
- > the west side of **Jones Lane** from **Buck Lane** to **Doe Lane**.

Weather permitting, construction is anticipated to begin sometime during the late-Summer of this year. A more informative and detailed construction notice will be sent once a specific construction start date has been selected. In addition, MCDOT will delineate the excavation site and post signs prior to starting construction. An inspector will be on-site and available throughout the entire construction phase to address any issues you may have.
