

Display B Cross-Section of Fontaine Street

Fontaine Street has 50-feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 21-feetwide, leaving 29-feet of total available right of way or 14.5-feet of right of way on each side of the road.



Display C Cross-Section of Goya Drive

Goya Drive has 70feet of total public
right of way. The
roadway is 36-feetwide, leaving 34-feet
of total available right
of way or 17-feet of
right of way on each
side of the road.



Display D Cross-Section of Greenleaf Avenue

Greenleaf Avenue has 60-feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 26-feetwide, leaving 34-feet of total available right of way or 17-feet of right of way on each side of the road.



Display E Cross-Section of Gainsborough Road

Gainsborough Road has 60-feet of total public right of way. The roadway is a variable 18 to 26-feetwide, leaving 42 to 34feet of total available right of way or 21 to 17-feet of right of way on each side of the road.



Display F Cross-Section of Mary Cassatt Drive

Mary Cassatt Drive has 60-feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 20-feet-wide, leaving 40-feet of total available right of way or 20-feet of right of way on each side of the road.



Display G Cross-Section of Ivymount Terrace

Ivymount Terrace has 60-feet of total public right of way. The roadway is 23-feetwide, leaving 37-feet of total available right of way or 18.5-feet of right of way on each side of the road.



PROJECT JUSTIFICATION

- MCDOT evaluates requests for pedestrian facilities based on their ability to serve a public use and enhance public safety.
- Sidewalk Program Goal: To remove pedestrians from the path of vehicular traffic and create a separation between the pedestrian and the roadway, setting up the infrastructure to promote walking to short distance destinations and public transportation in furtherance of the County's Climate Action Plan.
- Sidewalks will connect to existing network of sidewalks and provide safer pedestrian access to schools, public transportation and other pedestrian attractions.










TREE REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT

- The removal of 67 trees is anticipated to facilitate the construction of sidewalks. 15 additional trees
 will be removed due to poor condition or extensive trunk decay.
- 3 trees will be planted for every 1 tree removed or 201 trees will be planted back into the public rights of way in the Willerburn Acres community.
- The species and placement of the trees are selected by the County Arborist.

- Residents may request a tree be planted on private property via the <u>TreeMontgomery.org</u> website.









COSTS & ASSESSMENTS

- The estimated cost for installing the Willerburn Acres sidewalks is approximately \$1,451,280. Costs include construction, inspection, and administrative costs.
- Funding for this project will be provided under the County's Sidewalk Program, CIP No. 0506747
- Although sidewalk installation is statistically proven to augment property values, there are no properties considered to be specially benefited by the proposed improvement. Therefore, no properties are expected to be assessed.


