



Tuckerman Lane Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements Public Workshop, June 15, 2017

Department of Transportation (MCDOT) invites you to attend public workshop No. 3 to learn about the latest updates for the Facility Planning Phase I Study of Tuckerman Lane Pedestrian & Bicycle Improvements.

On November 16, 2015, MCDOT's Division of Transportation Engineering (DTE) hosted the second public information meeting to share the initial concepts that MCDOT had developed for the short and long term pedestrian and bicycle improvements throughout Tuckerman Lane from Gainsborough Road to Old Georgetown Road. The proposed short term improvements include addressing immediate safety needs at selected locations. The proposed long term improvements include multi-modal transportation facilities to reflect the Master Plan recommendations along the corridor. More than 24 citizens were in the attendance, MCDOT received a total of 22 written comments in response to the public meeting. Out of 22 comments, 19 were in support of pedestrian and/or

he Montgomery County bicycle improvements. The comments addressed concerns on the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists, speeding along the corridor, intersection safety, street lighting improvements, or further extending the project scope to Falls Road.
