Pursuant to Section 31-48, Montgomery County Code 2014, as amended, and COMCOR 31.48.01 Residential Permit Parking Guidelines, the County Executive or his designee shall conduct a virtual Public Hearing at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, March 23, 2022, via the internet-based platform known as Zoom™ (the “Hearing”) to consider the creation of a new Residential Permit Parking Area (the “RPPA”) in Silver Spring.

The Hearing shall be conducted virtually via Zoom™. A link to the virtual meeting space will be provided to all registrants prior to the Hearing date. Special accommodations will be addressed as needed.

The Quebec Terrace RPPA would be located south of Piney Branch Road along the north side of Quebec Terrace between the eastern property line of 1028 Quebec Terrace to the western property line of 1006 Quebec Terrace (north) and along the public portions of the south side to include the western property line of 1005 Quebec Terrace (Lot 2) through approximately 12 feet east of 1013 Quebec Terrace (Lot 6) and the western property line of 1017 Quebec Terrace (Lot 8) to approximately 28.34 feet east of 1021 Quebec Terrace (Lot 10). Establishing this RPPA in advance will allow residents to petition for the implementation of residential permit parking during the construction phase or once the Purple Line starts operating.

Further details, including the proposed area are more fully described in exhibits that are available for examination at the offices of the Montgomery County Department of Transportation, Division of Traffic Engineering and Operations located at 100 Edison Park Drive, 4th Floor, Gaithersburg, Maryland 20878.

After the aforesaid Hearing, the public will have until 5 p.m. on Wednesday, April 6, 2022, to submit additional comments at the address below. The presiding Hearing Officer shall report the Officer’s findings and recommendations to the County Executive, and the County Executive will issue a written decision.
