REMOVE: (T.O. 190-77)  
Speed Limit 30 MPH

In Rockville: on Longdraft Road between Quince Orchard Road and Cloppers Road.

REMOVE: (T.O. 918)  
Stop

In UpCounty: on Longdraft Road at Clopper Road so as to stop north bund traffic on Longdraft Road.

REMOVE: (T.O. 219-78)  
No Parking Any Time

In Rockville: on the west side of Longdraft Road from a point approximately 480' south of Clopper Road (south property line of 17712 Longdraft Road) to the north curblines of the southernmost intersection with "old" Longdraft Road.

REMOVE: (T.O. 219-78)  
No Parking Any Time

In Rockville: on the east side of Longdraft Road from the extended south curblines of Longdraft Court to Clopper Road.

1a INSTALL:  
Speed Limit 30

In Montgomery Village: on Longdraft Road from Quince Orchard Road to Clopper Road.

2a INSTALL:  
No Parking Any Time

In Montgomery Village: on both sides of Longdraft Road from Great Seneca Highway to Clopper Road.
