Subject – Creation of New Greenwich Forest Residential Permit Parking Area in Bethesda	Executive Order No. 7-17	Subject Suffix

Pursuant to Section 31-48, Montgomery County Code (2014), as amended, and COMCOR §31.48.01, *et seq.*, the County Executive or his designee shall conduct a public hearing at 7 p.m. on Monday, June 19, 2017, in the Lobby Level Auditorium, Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe Street, Rockville, Maryland, to consider the creation of a new Residential Permit Parking Area (RPPA), proposed Greenwich Forest RPPA and modification to the boundary of the existing Huntington Terrace–Arylawn RPPA in Bethesda.


The proposed Greenwich Forest RPPA in Bethesda would be bound by Glenwood Road (north), Old Georgetown Road (MD 187) (east), Huntington Parkway (south) and Irvington Avenue (west).

The Huntington Terrace – Arylawn RPPA would revert back to its previous boundary of Ewing Drive and Johnson Avenue (north), Old Georgetown Road (MD 187) (east), Roosevelt Street (south) and Garfield Street (west). A more detailed description of both areas is available for examination in the exhibits at the offices of the Montgomery County Department of Transportation, Division of Traffic Engineering and Operations located at 100 Edison Park Drive, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Gaithersburg, Maryland 20878.

After the aforesaid Hearing, the public will have until 5 p.m. on Monday, July 3, 2017, to submit additional comments. The Hearing Officer will report his findings and recommendations to the County Executive who will issue a written decision.
