Summary: This temporary regulation amends the civil penalty for violation of § 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article in compliance with the state law and decision of the Chief Judge of the District Court of Maryland. The civil penalty to be imposed for a violation of § 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article is \$250.

Background: § 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article allows for a local jurisdiction to have a School Bus Safety Camera program so long as there is enacting legislation at the local level. Montgomery County Code Chapter 31, Section 9 B authorizes a School Bus Safety Camera program and further provides that the civil penalty be up to a maximum of \$250. The corresponding Executive Regulation only permits a civil penalty of \$125. The Chief Judge of the District Court sets the civil penalty to be reflected on the uniform civil citation.
