EMIHS 5-minute Lineup Drill



CROUP (or . . . laryngotracheobronchitis)

Causes:

- Viral infection
- Swelling
- Mucous production
- Airflow restriction

Most often seen in children less than 5



Symptoms:

- Fever
- Malaise
- Characteristic
 "barking cough"

What to do about it:



- Keep the child calm crying and agitation further irritate the airways and increase swelling
- **Treat hypoxia** with blow by oxygen, be prepared for BVM ventilation in extreme cases
- **RAMERIC**
- **Steroids** (dexamethasone, even in mild cases)
- Nebulized epinephrine for moderate to severe cases after other treatments
- Intramuscular epinephrine 1st medication in severe cases
