Transport of patients in police custody

Must:

- ✓ Be a <u>patient</u> with a chief complaint (including undifferentiated agitation)
- Be transporting to a medical facility
- Receive all appropriate medical assessments and treatments
- Be accompanied by a law enforcement officer in the transport unit



Must not:

- Allow police to dictate any treatment or transport decisions
- Allow any patient to be handcuffed behind their back, restrained face down, or positioned in any other way that compromises patient assessment or care
- Provide medical equipment (reeves) solely for law enforcement purposes or restraint

Severe agitation is a condition that must be appropriately investigated, managed, and documented
