## You got ROSC... now what?



YOU NOW HAVE A

**Critically Unstable Patient**

PROCEED IMMEDIATELY TO

**ROSC Protocol**

- Notify your team of ROSC
- Alert closest CIC of incoming ROSC patient and consult as necessary
- Obtain and transmit 12-lead ECG
- Discuss patient needs with 2<sup>nd</sup> ALS provider

**Listen to your assessment findings!**

**Are there indications of:**

- Hypoxia (SP02)
- Hypo/Hyperventilation (ETCO2)
- Hypotension (NIBP/MAP)
- Rhythm/Rate Disturbances

**Treat prior to transport to prevent re-arrest and support circulation to the brain**



The resuscitation doesn't stop when ROSC is achieved

Post ROSC care must be thoughtful and deliberate
