## Two paramedics - One AFRA









You must ensure that the patient gets the resources they need in the most appropriate manner

Question: "If I have 2 paramedics, should I place the 2<sup>nd</sup> AFRA in service on an ALS2 call?"

The individual unit officer responding to the call has the authority to make this decision and it will vary upon the situation.

## Considerations:

- Decisions must be consistent with the Operational Doctrine Statement
- On cardiac arrests the unit officer has a designated role that cannot be filled if they are acting as an ALS provider
- The extra manpower could be beneficial for carrying a patient up or down stairs or pit crew CPR
- Placing a responding unit in service to improve county coverage is subordinate to good medicine. Take one call at a time.
