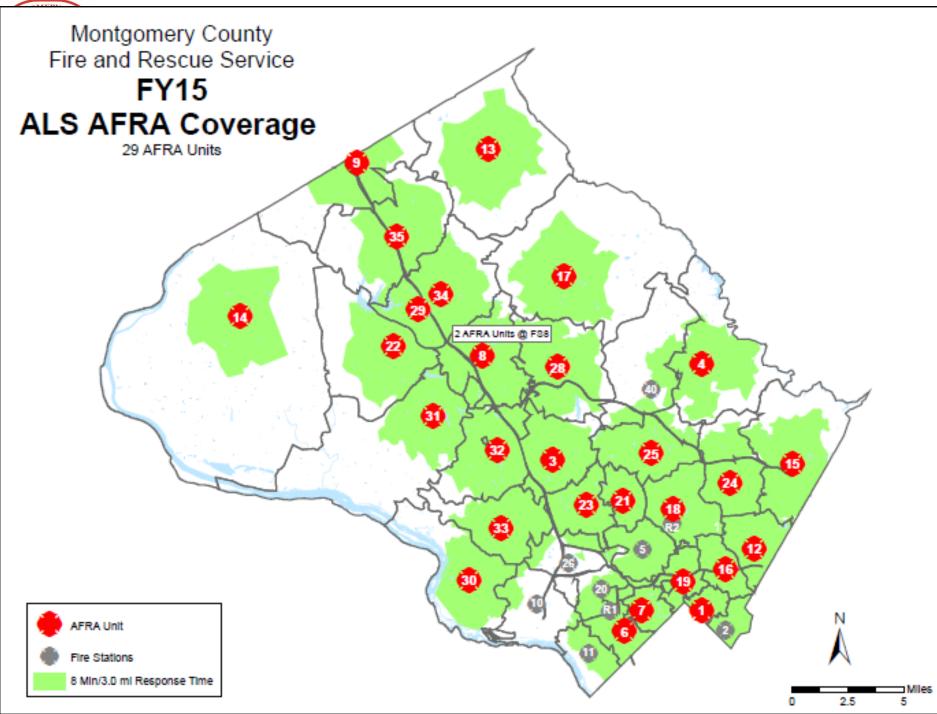

Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Service **Population Zones**

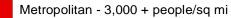

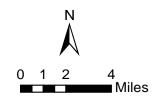
Fire Management Zones
