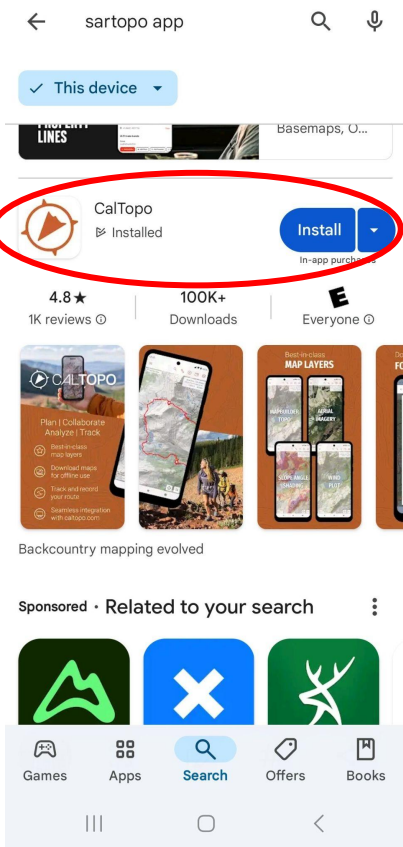

What is CalTopo

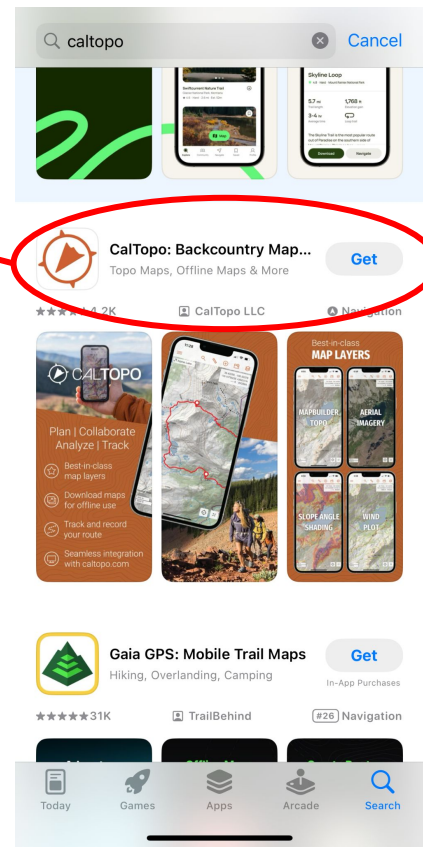
In 2010, after another middle of the night search and rescue mission with limited mapping resources, Matt Jacobs set out to pull some digital maps together into a tool that searchers could use to make some planning decisions. After adding the ability to draw objects over the digital map layers, then import gpx tracks, CalTopo (then SARTopo) quickly grew into the number one tool for managing SAR missions across the US. In 2017, Jacobs transitioned to full time work on the program, and began hiring shortly thereafter. The mobile app followed a few years later, making the job of the incident management team infinitely more efficient.

CalTopo is now used not only in Search and Rescue, but also by recreational users as the most advanced planning tool for backcountry travel. On the first response side, the use has expanded to include law enforcement, child abduction response, urban and wilderness fire, event planning, and much more.

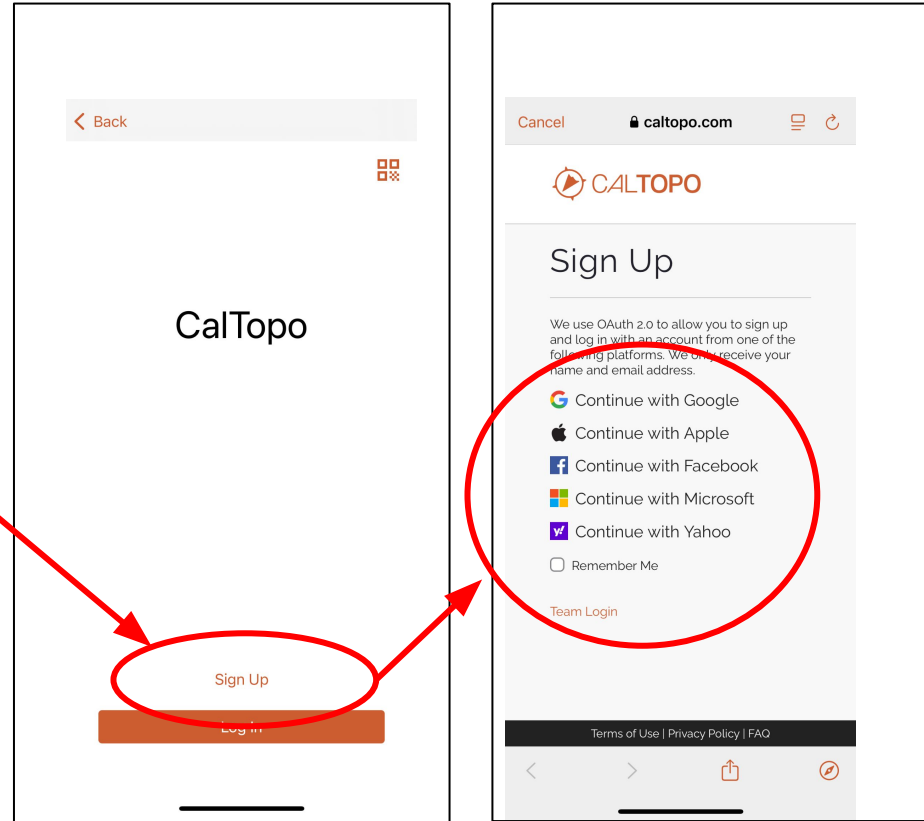

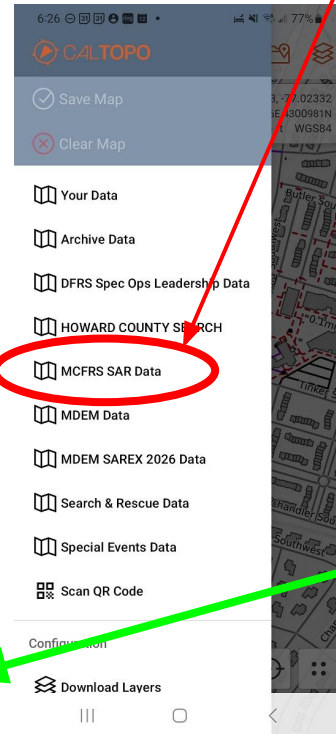
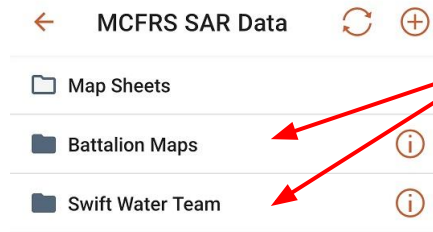

- ❖ Then select your sign up option of choice.

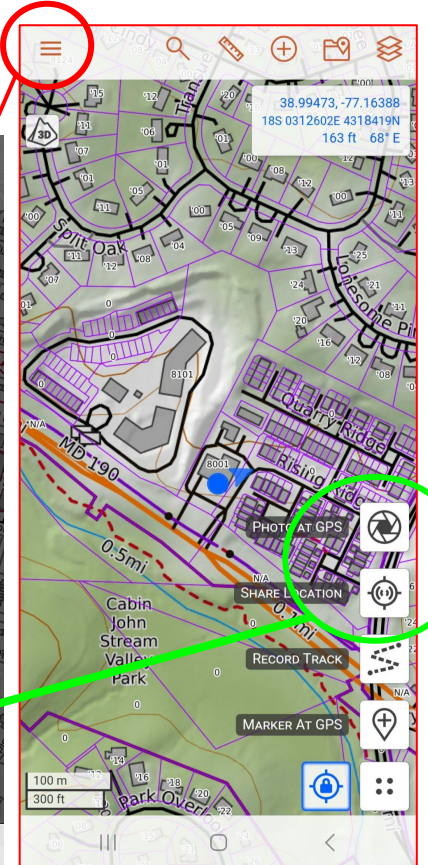

 - Select the appropriate shared map for incident



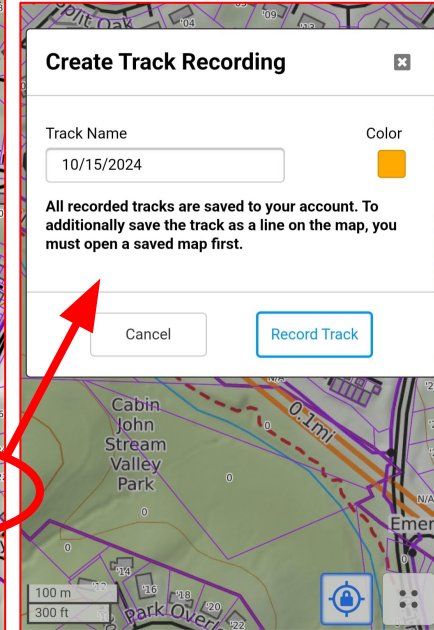
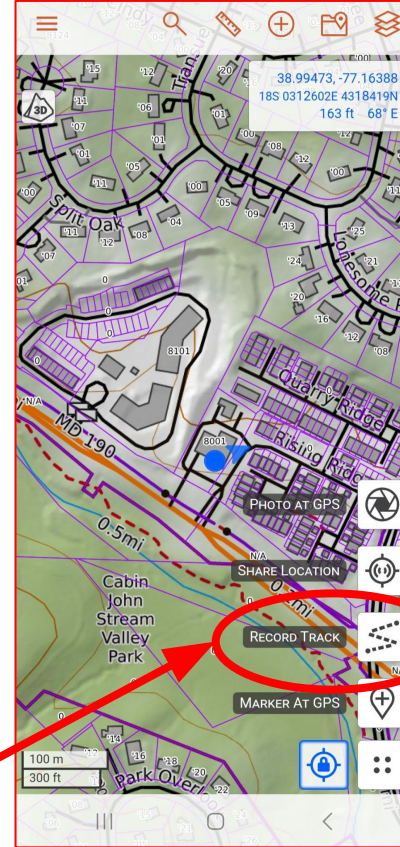
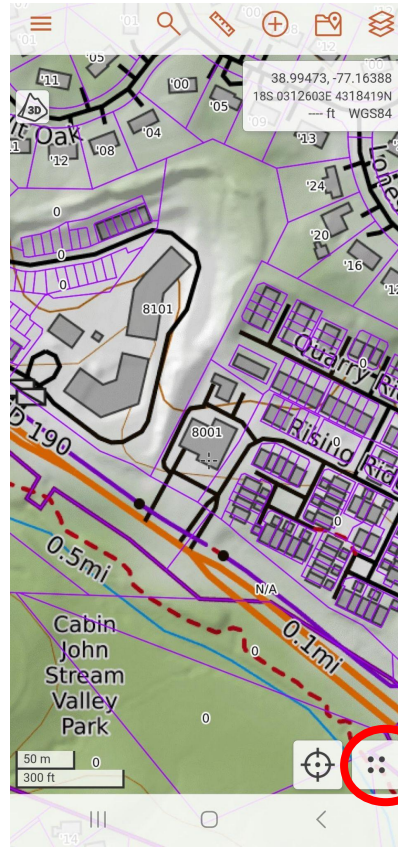

- Label track name as Unit # 7XX
- Click record track

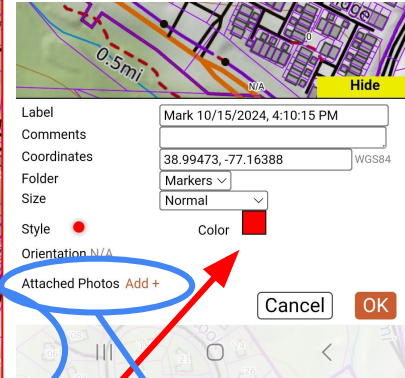
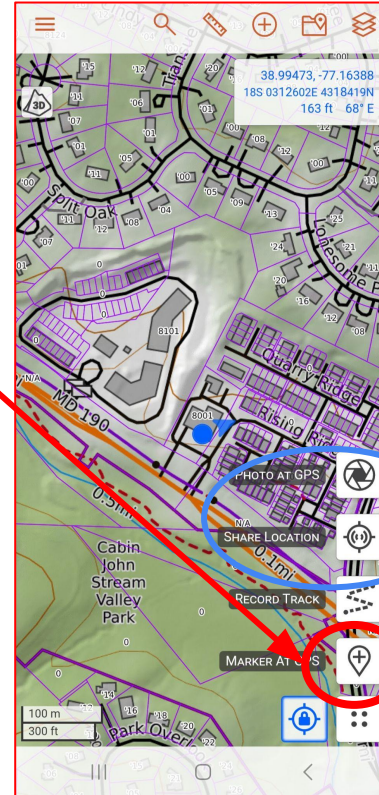

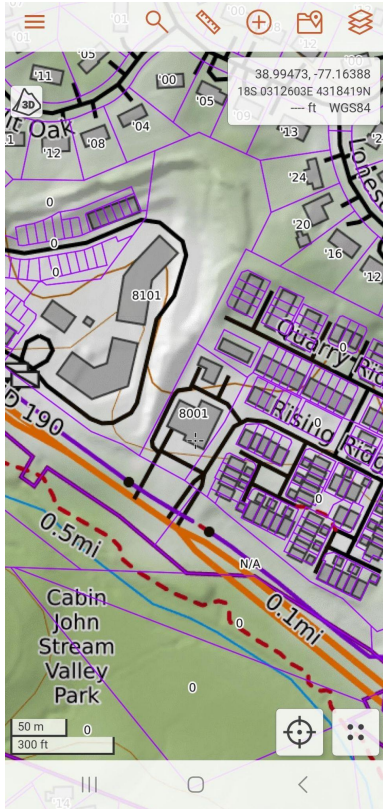
Drop Markers

- Change color and style as necessary
(Your discretion)
- Select “Ok”

Select stacked sheets icon

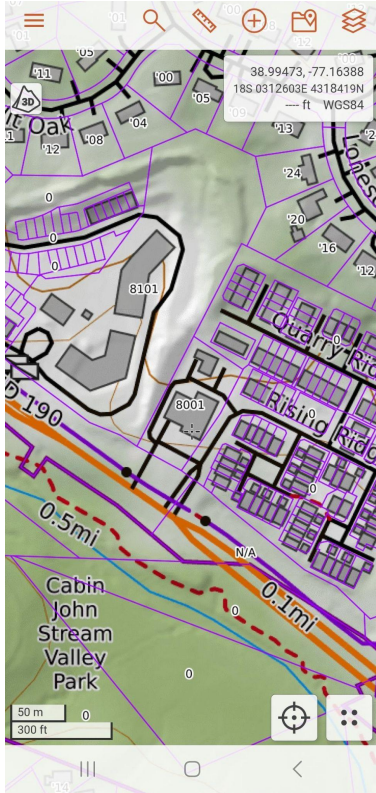
- ❖ Base Layers, Map Sheets, Overlays and Other Map View Options can be selected from this location

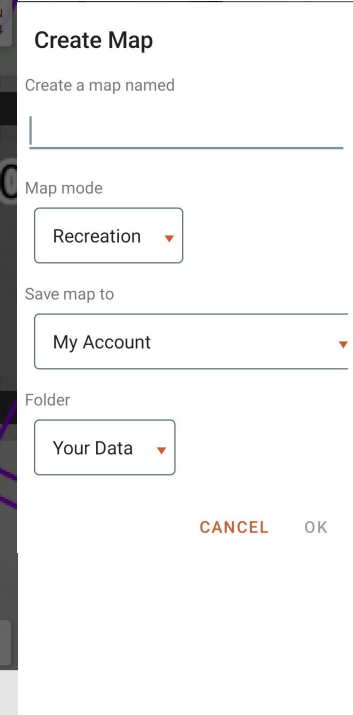
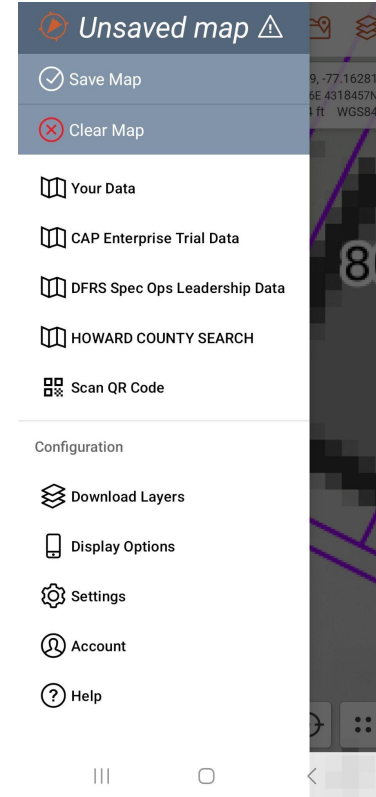

❖ Saving a New Map

- Open the App
- Insert and Save a Marker (See Slide 5)
- Open the File Icon (Top Left) (Slide 7)
- 2 New Options which were Grayed Out are now available. Save Map and Clear Map
- Saving the map will Open the Create Map Screen.
 - Enter a Name for the Map
 - **Change Map Mode to SAR**
 - Save Map to Mont. Co Fire Folder
 - Click OK



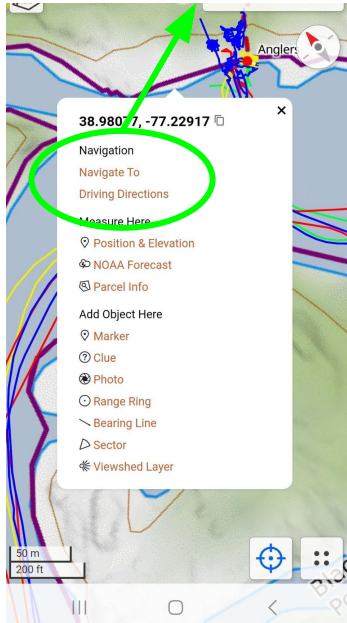

How to Use the Navigation Function

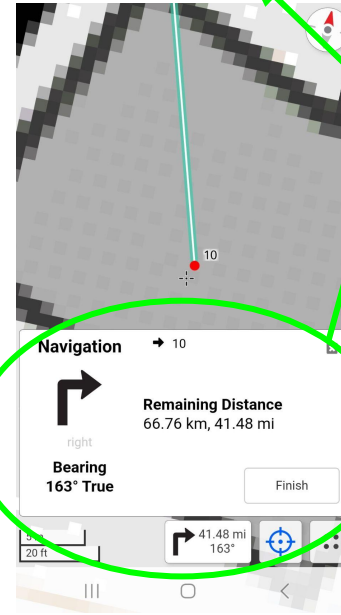
- ❖ Click on Location
- ❖ Select Navigate To or Driving Directions



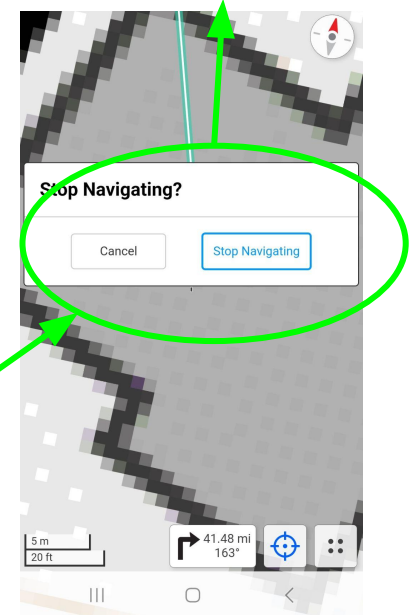
- ❖ Follow Highlighted Line

- ❖ Navigation Box can be expanded by Clicking on it



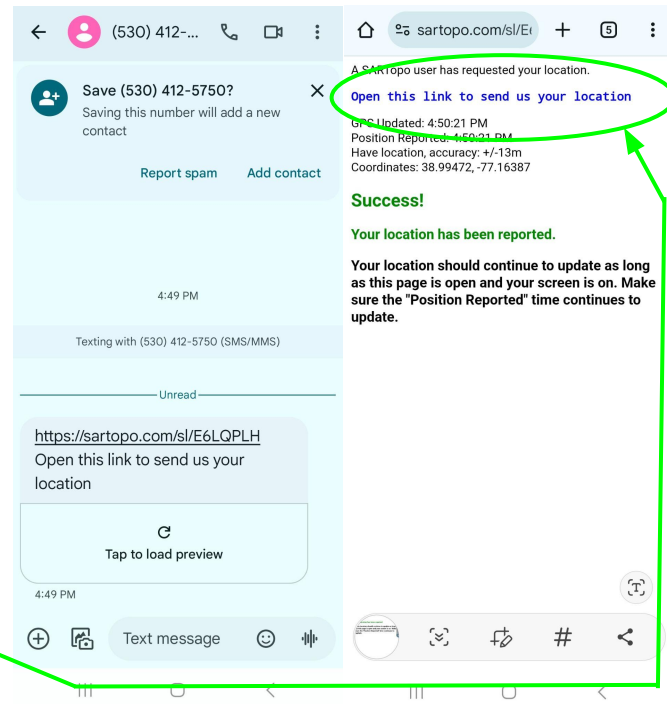
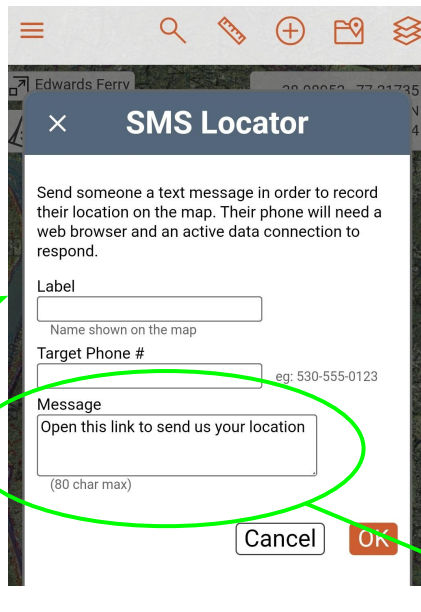
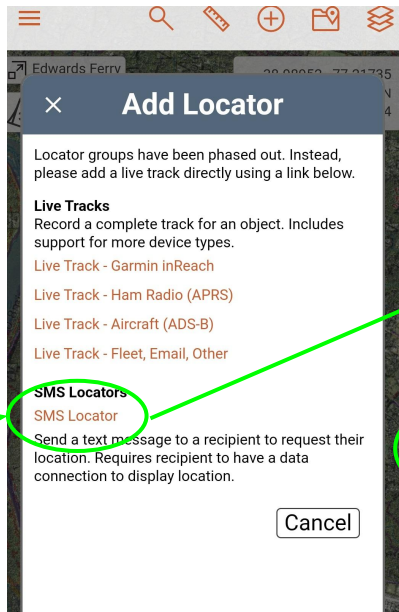
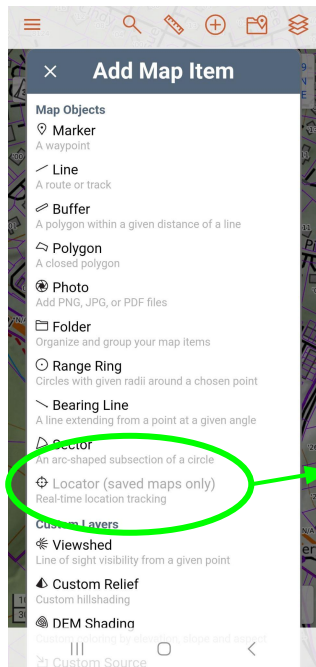
