Bay Door Remote Placement on Apparatus



- MCFRS has recently had two significant bay door strikes involving doors that did <u>NOT</u> have a timer.
- If there is no timer, the <u>only</u> way the door can come down is if the remote or wall switch were inadvertently pressed.
- To combat this, the Safety Section recommends that all bay door remotes be placed <u>on the</u> <u>driver's visor</u> to prevent interference with other switches/buttons/radios etc.
- If your remote is broken/missing a clip, please go through the proper channels to have it replaced.
